Establishment of Alternative Education Programs

Proposals from parents or students for the establishment of an alternative educational program shall be submitted in writing to the superintendent of designee.

“Alternative education program” means a school or separate class group designed to meet students’ unique educational needs, interests and learning styles. Alternative programs assist students in achieving the academic standards of the district and the state.

Proposals for alternative education programs shall include the following:

1. Goals;
2. Criteria for enrollment;
3. Proposed budget;
4. Staffing;
5. Location;
6. Assurance of nondiscrimination.

Proposals must be submitted to the superintendent for review and approval. The superintendent shall notify the Board of any such proposal(s). Proposed alternative education programs shall be approved at the adoption of the next Local Service Plan.
